District No. 53 in the Town of Minnetonka, County of Hennepin & State of Minnesota
 aforesaid on the 15th day of March A.D. 1871 at 7 O'clock P.M. the following persons
 citizens of the said Town of Minnetonka met for the purpose of organizing a cemetery
 association to wit: K.H. Whipple, Henry Ogia, George Whipple, David Locke, ~~William S. Shover~~
 Thomas Robinson, B. T. Shaver, W.S. Frear, and Y.E. A. Shaver.

Upon Motion K.H. Whipple was elected chairman
 & Y.E. A. Shaver Secretary.

It was then determined by vote that this association shall
 be known as the Groveland Cemetery Association and that its ~~affairs~~ affairs shall be
 managed by a board of 5 Trustees. Those were then balloted for resulting in the election
 of K.H. Whipple, Henry Ogia, George Whipple, David Locke, and William S. Shover.

Of those was decided by lot that William S. Shover ~~is~~
 constituted the first class; Henry Ogia and David Locke the second class;
 K.H. Wipple and George Whipple the third class.

Decided the time for the future annual
 meeting to be the first Saturday in March.
